The Deft. also moves upon his first plea to the plaintiff's original declaration as a plea to the plaintiff's amended declaration. and thereupon the matters of Law arising upon the said demurrer being argued it seems to the Court that the said declaration and the matters therein contained are not sufficient in Law for the plaintiff who sues as well for the Commonwealth as for himself in this behalf. He has & maintains his aforesaid action against the defendant. Therefore it is considered by the Court that the plaintiff take nothing by his bill but for his false clamour being merged. And that the deft go thereof without day and recover against the plaintiff his costs by him about his defence in this behalf expended.
