James Wick who has been committed to the Jail of this County charged with stabbing William Wick with an intention to kill or maim the said William Wick was set to the bar in custody of the Jailor of this County (the Court summoned for his examination having failed to meet) whereupon for reasons appearing to the Court the examination is adjourned till to morrow, and the prisoner is remanded to Jail -

Ordered that James Mapeburg Lewis & Frederick & Stephen Murdaugh or any two of them let to the Court undertake the repairs of the Bridge across Mapeburg Mill race & make rept. &c.

Ordered that the Court be adjourned till to morrow morning 9 o'clock.
