Leroy a slave the property of James Roschelle of this County who had been committed to the jail of this County charged with feloniously & burglariously breaking and entering into the dwelling house of William B Bailey on the night of the 21st of April 1834. and stealing, taking & carrying away from thence one watch in the possession of the said Bailey - was this day set to the bar in custody of the Jailor of this County (the Court summoned for his trial having failed to meet) ^{and being arraigned pleaded not guilty.} and thereupon sundry witnesses were sworn and examined on behalf of the Commonwealth and the prisoner was heard by Augustin Claiborne his Counsel. On consideration whereof it is the opinion of the Court as the case appears to them that the prisoner is not guilty and that he be discharged from further prosecution for the said supposed offence.

Larn Brown a free man of colour late of this County of Southampton who has been committed to the jail of this said County charged with feloniously & burglariously breaking and entering the dwelling house of William B Bailey on the night of the 21st April last and stealing taking and carrying away from thence one watch the property of the said Bailey, was this day set to the bar in custody of the Jailor of this County (the Court summoned for his trial having failed to meet) ^{and being arraigned pleaded not guilty.} and thereupon sundry witnesses were sworn & examined on behalf of the Commonwealth and the prisoner was fully heard by Counsel. On consideration whereof it is the opinion of the Court as the case appears to them that the prisoner is not guilty as in pleading he has alleged, and that he be discharged from further prosecution for the said offence.

On motion of Geo B Chappell Esq leave is given them to retake separation & liquors at their store in this County. It appearing to the Court that the place proposed is well fit & convenient for the neighbourhood -

William D Hodges Esq. who has been duly licensed to practice the law in the Court of this Commonwealth leave is given him to practice in the Court and thereupon he qualified according to Law -

Darius Bryant a Minister of the Gospel this day appeared in Court & took the oath of allegiance to this Commonwealth
