Ordered that the shiff out of any contingent monies in his hands pay to Miles Elgray the sum of one dollar for services in carrying a witness to Court in the case of the Poor. S. Barkan.

Jepet Barkan who is charged on oath by Rebecca Johnson a free single woman of this County with being the father of her bastard child this day appeared in Court in discharge of his recognizance and the said Rebecca Johnson and sundry witnesses were sworn and examined touching the premises and the said Jepet Barkan fully heard by counsel it is the opinion of the Court as the case appears to them that the said Jepet Barkan is the father of the said child and that the said child is likely to become chargeable to the County. Therefore it is ordered that the said Jepet Barkan pay to the Treasurer of the Poor of this County the sum of twenty dollars annually for the space of five years and seven months from this day in case the said child shall live so long.

And whereupon the said Jepet Barkan together with George A. Barkan & Hardy Joyner his securities here in Court severally acknowledged themselves indebted to Littleton Waller Tazewell Governor of this Commonwealth the said Jepet Barkan in the sum of One hundred and ten dollars and the said George A. Barkan and Hardy Joyner in the sum of fifty five dollars each of their respective goods & chattels land & tenements take land and to the said Governor and his successors for the use of the Commonwealth rendered. Yet upon this condition that if the said Jepet Barkan shall observe and perform the above order of the Court this day made against him then the above recognizance to be void or else to remain in full force & virtue.

Ordered that the Court be adjourned till the next Court in cause
