Bells vs. Williams' ad. Sci. fa. in lehy. The debt by demand demands generally to the said writ and the plaintiff joins in the said demand and the matters of Law arising upon the said demand being argued it seems to the Court that the Law is for the plaintiff. Therefore it is decided and ordered that the said debt be overruled and that the plaintiff have Costs against the debt for the debt and costs in the said writ mentioned and his costs by him expended in suing & prosecuting this writ. To be levied of the goods & chattels of the said William Williams in the hands of the debtors to be administered.

Lenon vs. Lenon. lehy. Decree according to decree filed &c. (to be filed)

Turners vs. Drury's ad. Sci. fa. On motion of the Court leave is given him to withdraw the pleas by him formerly pleaded and to plead answer and the said pleas being accordingly withdrawn the debt pleaded payment and filed a special plea in writing and issues being joined a jury was sworn to try the issues to wit. Bailey Bryant, Bolling J. B. Barrett, Thos. M. Dowling, Samuel Polkirkhorn, George C. Nicholson, Robert Murray, James M. Mello, Jacquesen felks, Jos. B. Whitehead, William Blount, James Blythe & Calvin J. Stephenson Verdict & judgment for plaintiff for debt in declaration mentioned with interest & costs &c.

Ordered that St. Mordant, Wm. A. Spark & J. D. Mapenbury or any 2 of them let to contract under the repair of Bridge across Mapenbury Mill Run & make up &c.
