

Commonwealth v. Myrick. Inst. Plea of not guilty to the presentment of the Court. 205
A declaration of Rebecca Cooper. in writing renouncing all provision made for her by the
Will of her deceased husband John Cooper dec. was proved by Thomas Bradder one of the
witnesses thereto.

John Floyd Governor of Virginia vs. Holt and Nassau. Upon a return of a writ of Habeas Corpus - This day
came as well the attorney for the Commonwealth as the Defendant Nassau by his Attorney
who being fully heard it is considered by the Court that the said Governor for the use
of the Commonwealth may have execution against the goods and chattels lands and tenements
of the said Defendant Nassau for the sum of One hundred dollars in the
writ aforesaid specified according to the form and effect of his recognizance therein
mentioned. And also that the said Floyd Governor for the use of the said Common-
wealth recover against the Defendant Nassau the costs expended in suing forth
and prosecuting the writ. And the said Def in Henry &c.

And for reasons appearing to the Court and on motion of the Defendants by his Attorney
the Court recommended the Legislature of Virginia that the amount of the said judgment
be by them remitted.

Commonwealth v. Bryant Harris Priest. Leave to file Infr. in Dft Bryant &
sum to answer awarded and new proof awarded to the Dft Harris & the
Foster are in Blunt are & Chy. On motion for reasons appearing to the Court
it is ordered that the Injunction ^{and order} the Plaintiff in this case as the 15th day of May
1815 be dissolved that the bill of the Plaintiff be dismissed and that he pay to the
Dft his costs about his defence in this behalf expended.

aforesaid and conditioned according to Law. And the said Parker refusing to give
the said security it is ordered that his duties and powers as Guardian aforesaid be revoked
and annulled.
