And the said Charles Atlett failing to give security for the payment of the said sum of money shall be committed to the custody of the Sheriff of this County to be confined in the common jail of the same until he shall give security by attorney into recognizance in the sum of £210 with sufficient security to abate the above order of the Court or otherwise discharged by due course of Law.
