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Court that the sum be affirmed and that the Officer never against the appeal the
sum of \$13.45 pcts & \$1.99 cents the amount of the original judgment together with
the cost of the same from the 16th day of March 1835. And the costs by him
expended in securing the said appeal.

Ordered that the account of Samuel H. Barnes concerning the \$13.52 cents be
certified to the Auditor of Public accounts for his examination & payment.

and thereupon he entered into bond with security conditioned according to Law which bond
was acknowledged & recorded. the said Clayton also took the several oaths required
by Law.

Bennett H. Whitehead. Henry Nelson. Josiah Pick. Benjamin Burns. Elizabeth Thomas.
Benjamin Barrett. Nelson. J. B. Barlett. Mills Johnson. & Elizabeth Whitehead. John M. D.
and the bond of John C. Turner with cheerit. - Dick Whitehead (Big) & Dick Whitehead (Little)

Ordered that the Court be adjourned till the first day of the next Term.
