

At a Court held for the County of Southampton on Monday the 19<sup>th</sup> day of October 1825

The Court proceeded to elect a Clerk to supply the vacancy caused by the death of Samuel Robble  
my late Clerk of this Court and upon taking the vote of the Court viva voce Littelton R. Edwards  
was unanimously elected. Whereupon the said Littelton R. Edwards was declared duly elected  
Clerk of this Court for the term of seven years next ensuing. And thereupon the said Littelton R.  
Edwards together with Augustin Claborn, Edward Beale, John N. Mason & Samuel B. Harris  
entered into & acknowledged a bond in the penalty of three thousand dollars conditioned as follows  
which bond is ordered to be recorded - the said Edwards also took the oath of fidelity to the  
United States, the oath against Duress  
(Commencement) the oath to support the Constitution of the United States, the oath against Duress  
and the oath of Office -
