

At a Court held for the County of Southampton on Monday the 19th day of October 1825

The Court proceeded to elect a Clerk to supply the vacancy created by the death of Samuel R. Schelle.
Mr. John Cobb of this Court and upon taking the vote of the Court was voted Lilliaton R. Edwards
was unanimously elected. Whereupon the said Lilliaton R. Edwards was declared duly elected
Clerk of this Court for the term of seven years next ensuing. And thereupon the said Lilliaton R.
Edwards together with Augustus (Hathorne, Edward Beale John H. Mason & Samuel B. Harris
his associates entered into & acknowledged a bond in the penalty of three thousand dollars conditioned as follows
which bond is ordered to be recorded - the said Edwards also took the oath of fidelity to this
Court and the oath of Office -
