Turner at Bailey Bridge road & running by Pipe & Blot. by Duke Jones through Joe
Jackson land by William joyner across the Railroad on Edmonson Turner land to the
lower corner of Mr. Branch's Sub plantation to the State line. - Ordered that Duke
Jones, Henry Moore, Rich^r Mason & John J. Blot or any 3 of them being sworn & oaths
the way proposed for the said road & report to the Court the conveniences & inconveniences
+ that will result as well to individuals as to the publick if such road be opened as proposed.
Atch^r J. William or John Ferguson et al granted Margaret Nelson who made oath & gave bond &
+ security according to Law.

+ Ordered that Alfred Story, John Hargrove & Henry Maget approve and state &
Atch^r J. William or Benjamin B. Bailey et al granted Delight & Bailey who made oath & gave
+ bond & security according to Law.

Ordered that the Clerk examine the records & report to next Court whether an order
has been made authorizing the turning a road from Jones Church across Blot's mill
+ to the Super County line & whether Com^rs have been appointed to receive the same -
William Ridley is appointed Surveyor of the Road on the road of Bradley William
+ discharged & that the usual bonds work therein &c

of Arthur L. Carr et al. be committed to the hands of Bay & Derry Staff of this County for
action according to Law.
