

Mr. Savage Esq. Governor of the Commonwealth of Virginia this said Remo in the
sum of \$100 and the said Secord in the sum of \$30 each of their respective taxes &
chattel taxes & assessments to be levied and to the said Governor this charge for the
use of the Commonwealth returned. Yet upon the condition that if the said Remo
shall keep the peace and be of good behaviour towards all the citizens of this Com-
monwealth more especially towards Robt. Drury of this County then the foregoing is
to be void & each remain in full force.

It being represented to the Court that the navigation of Blackwater river is obstructed by cause
of the erection of Mr. Clunys bridge across the same at or near a place called Franklins because there is no draw
with therein so as to admit the passage of vessels through the same: and it being also represented that destruction of
a draw work on the said bridge is rendered necessary by the great internal improvements which have been already
made & those which are being made, it being manifest that all obstructions in our rivers should be removed when
practicable: and it being deemed a matter of great importance to the citizens of this County as well as the citizens of
the State that a remedy should be speedily applied to the present obstructions created by the erection of
which the said bridge is built this Court taking the subject into consideration with order that Messrs. Davis
James Williams, Robert Henry & William Adams or any three of them who are hereby appointed Com-
missioners for the purpose proceed to confer with and act with the Commissioners to be appointed by the Hon-
orable Court of Chancery, and inquire, and decide whether the destruction of the said bridge can be best removed by
the addition of a draw work to the said bridge, or by the removal of the present bridge to a site with
said river beyond which the navigation will not be obstructed and make report of their proceedings
to this Court.

Ordered that the Court be adjourned till the first day of the next Term.
