

persons offered. Therefore it is ordered that the prisoners be carried by the Sheriff
before some Justice of the Peace to be proceeded against accordingly to law -
Henry Drury of this County who stands committed to the Gaol of this County charged
with having maliciously feloniously & dangerously cut the throat of one Samuel Rogers
with intent to do him to murder & to leave his body to rot in the said Gaol. Rogers
was set to the bar on custody of the Gaoler of this County. Whereupon Drury
was sworn and examined & the prisoners heard who on oath offered the Court of
this County and all the circumstances of this case are of opinion that the
prisoners ought to be tried for the said Offences at the next Assizes to be held at the
County of Kent for this County and therefore the prisoners are remanded to Gaol -

Be it remembered that John Clapham Joseph Clark & James H. Love have in
Court severally acknowledged themselves indebted to the said William Rogers Esq. Governor
of the Commonwealth of Virginia in the sum of \$100 each of their respective gold &
chattel bonds & Tenements to be levied and to the said Governor the same for the
use of the Commonwealth reserved. Yet upon this condition that if the said Clapham
Clark & Love shall personally appear before the Judge of the Circuit
Superior Court of Law & Chancery for this County on the first day of the next Term then
and there to give such evidence as they or either of them shall or on behalf of the Common-
wealth against Henry Drury who stands charged with felony themselves obliging to be
void unless to answer in full force -

Samuel Wells of this County who stands committed to the Gaol of this County for felonies
stealing & taking & carrying away in the 7th day of December 1835 one certain hog or
about the property of Henry Pope within this County was set to the bar on custody of
the Gaoler of this County the Court Summons for his examination having failed to make
Whereupon Drury witnesses were sworn & examined and the prisoners by his counsel
fully heard. The Court after hearing the Testimony on oath offered that the pri-
soners be tried at the next quarterly Court to be held for this County and therefore the
prisoners are remanded to Gaol -

Be it remembered that Henry Pope, Mills Pope & Peter Pope
have in Court severally acknowledged themselves indebted to the said William Rogers Esq.
Governor of the Commonwealth of Virginia in the sum of \$100 each of their respective
gold & chattel bonds & Tenements to be levied and to the said Governor the same for the
use of the Commonwealth reserved. Yet upon this condition that if the
said Henry Pope, Mills Pope & Peter Pope shall severally
personally appear before the Judge of this County Court & Southampton at the
Court to be held the first day of March next next then and there to give such
evidence as they or either of them shall or on behalf of the Commonwealth against
Samuel Wells and shall not depart thence without their said bond then the above
prisoners are to be void.
