

- x Admon on Margaret Becks est. granted to Jacob Jordan who ^{affirmed} & gave bond of security according to Law.
- x Ordered that Joshua Black, Mary Mager, Matthew Chick & Joel Black on any 3 of them app. said Est. &c.
- The Court with advice Benjamin Beckham Guardian to Cornelius Davis his daughter & Robert Davis nephew of Robert Davis and thereupon he gave true oaths bond & security according to Law -

- x John Gunder who stands committed to the Jail of this County charged with having unlawfully taken and entering into the house & shot under the name of Elizabeth Serous, and feloniously stealing & carrying away from thence on horse back being containing One hundred and fifty half dollars in specie the property of the said Elizabeth Serous, was set to trial in custody of the Sheriff of this County (the last Summons failed in execution having failed to meet) and thereupon Sunday witnesses were sworn and examined and the prisoner by his Counsel fully heard - the Court after hearing the evidence and upon all the circumstances of the case was of opinion that the prisoner ought to be tried for the said Offense at the next next Court of Law & Chancery to be held for this County - and therefore the prisoner is remanded to Jail.
- x Be it remembered that Thomas R. Gray, Elizabeth Serous, John Bishop and Melis Sumner have in Court personally acknowledged themselves to be indebted to the Hon. the Governor of the Commonwealth of Virginia on the sum of \$100 and of their respective 100 & 40 shillings land & tenements to the land and to the said Governor and his Successors for the use of the Commonwealth rendered by them upon this condition that if the said Gray, Serous, Bishop & Sumner shall personally make their personal appearance before the Judge of the Circuit Superior Court of Law & Chancery for this County on the first day of the next Term to give such evidence as they are each of them on 6 half of the Commonwealth against John Jordan who stands charged with felony and shall not depart thence without leave of the said Court then the above obligation to be void or else to remain in full force & virtue.
- x A black negro man ~~David~~ who at and charged with wilfully & maliciously feloniously assaulting with an intent to kill Nathaniel Boyant a free white citizen of the Commonwealth on or about the 22^d day of September 1835 and within this County, was this day set to the bar in custody of the Jailor of this County (the Summons for his examination having failed to meet) whereupon for reasons appearing to the Court the Court is of the opinion that the said David is a negro and is to be sent to the next Court of the Register of Allen (Joseph) & William Bailey for a negro or ex. & confined to the Court - Absent Robert J. Murgare Sent.
- x Admon on Samuel D. Boyant est. granted to Bradley Boyant who made oath & gave bond of security according to Law -
- x Ordered that Boyant & Lewis Thomas Bailey Jr. Jos. W. Parker & Amos Stephenson on any 3 app. said Est. &c.
