thereby according to Law.

+ A Writing bearing date the 8th day of July 1834 purporting to be the Last Will &
Testament of Jacob Mardough deceased was produced in Court by Stephen Mardough
the Executor thereon named for probate Whereupon James Mardough appeared by his
attorney and opposed the prob'g of the said Will. and therupon James D. H. Aikenhead &
Benjamin Story being sworn and examined and the parties fully heard. The Court after
fully hearing the evidence and upon mature deliberation thereof are of opinion that
the said writing is the true last Will & Testament of the said Jacob Mardough dec'd
that the said Testator at the time of executing the said Will was of sound & disposing mind
and memory and that he was under no undue influence. Therefore it is ordered that the
said writing be recorded as & for the last Will & Testament of the said Jacob Mardough dec'd.
And Stephen Mardough the Exec. thereon named is hereby authorized
upon himself the burden of the execution of the said Will. On motion of James Mardough
an order is given that the Will annexed is granted him & therupon he gave bond
to County & made oath according to Law &

+ A Writing bearing date the 16th day of February 1836 purporting to be the Last Will
and Testament of Dixon Gardner was produced in Court for probate and therupon
Nathaniel Coggeshall & Eliza Joyner the witnesses to the said writing and sundry other
witnesses were sworn & examined. The Court after hearing the Testimony are of opinion
that the writing aforesaid contains the true intentions & will of the said Dixon Gardner
dec'd that the said Gardner at the time of publishing the said Will was of sound &
disposing mind & memory and that he was under no undue influence. Therefore it is order-
ed that the said writing be recorded as the true & lawful Will of the said Dixon Gardner
dec'd. And therupon Dixon Gardner who will annexed is granted Nathaniel Coggeshall who
made oath & gave bond to County according to Law.
