Richard Bedfodeth of the County who stands committed to the Just of this County charged with
feloniously stealing taking and carrying away on the 17th day of February last three pieces of
pork from the meat house of Derryng Beale of the said County was this day set to the bar in cust-
dy of the Just of the County. The Court summoned for his examination having failed to make and
thereupon Derryng Beale was sworn and examined and the person by his name fully known. He烈nt
upon all the circumstances of the case array of opinion that he is one ought to be tried for the said
Supposed offence at the next Circuit Superior Court of Law & Chancery to be held for this County and
thereupon the forename is recommended to jail.

Be it remembered that Derryng Beale here in Court acknowledge himself to be indebted to Master
W. Jefferie Governor of the Commonwealth of Virginia in the just and full sum of one hundred
dollars of his goods & chattels lands and tenements to be levied and to the said Governor and his successors for
the use of the Commonwealth rendered. Yet upon this condition that if the said Derryng Beale shall
make his personal appearance before the Judge of our Circuit Superior Court of Law & Chancery for the
County on the first day of the next Term and give such evidence as he can on behalf of the Common-
wealth against Richard Bedfodeth who stands charged with larceny and shall not depart there
without leave of the said Court then the above recognizance to be void. Absent. Joseph J. Blane. Peter
Taylor &c. v. Long. Deb. The diff^t being retained in custody for want of bail committed to Court &
affirms judgment for the plaintiff for the sum of £30. 70 pds with interest from the 1st day of
January 1835 till paid & costs. And the diff^t is not privede in custody.
