The Court being then constituted the prisoner was set to the bar in custody of the Justices of the County & for reason appearing the examination of the said Bryant Edwards is adjourned to tomorrow, and therefore the said Bryant Edwards is remanded to jail.

At a Court Summons held for the County of Southampton on the 19<sup>th</sup> day of April 1836.

Willis Johnson who stands committed to the jail of this County charged with feloniously, wilfully  
and maliciously stabbing Everett Edwards at Crockettsville in this County on or about the 29<sup>th</sup>  
day of February 1836, with an intention to do damage to maine his friend, disable a fellow  
the said Edwards, was again set to the bar in custody of the keeper of the jail of this County on  
thereupon summing witness was sworn and examined as well on behalf of the Commonwealth as  
the prisoner and the prisoner was fully heard by counsel. On consideration whereof it is the opinion  
of the Court as the case appears to them that the said Willis Johnson ought to be tried for the offence  
of which he stands charged in the next Circuit Superior Court of Law & Chancery to be held for this  
County. And on the motion of the prisoner he is allowed to give bail himself to be bound in  
the sum of one thousand dollars and his securities on the sum of One hundred dollars each  
Whereupon the said Willis Johnson with Elizabeth Johnson and Talcott M. Scott  
his securities here in Court formally acknowledge themselves to be indebted to Nathaniel  
Robinson Esq. Lieutenant Governor of the Commonwealth of Virginia, for the sum of one thousand  
dollars & to say the said Willis Johnson in the sum of one thousand  
dollar and the said Elizabeth Johnson and Talcott M. Scott. in the sum of  
One hundred dollars each of their respective lands & tenements good & chattels to be  
levied and to the said Lieutenant Governor the Surety on his Office for the sum of the  
Commonwealth rendered. Yet upon this condition that if the said Willis Johnson shall  
make his personal appearance before the Judge of the Circuit Superior Court of Law &  
Chancery for this County on the first day of the next Term to stand his trial for the  
offence of which he stands charged and shall do and receive what by the said Court  
shall be ordered and shall not depart without leave of the said Court then this recogni-  
zance to be void or else to remain in full force & virtue.

Be it remembered that Richardson Edwards, Albridgeon Edwards, & John D. Beck  
herein Court severally acknowledged themselves to be indebted to Nathaniel Robinson  
esq. Lieutenant Governor of the Commonwealth of Virginia in the sum of one  
hundred dollars each of their respective goods & chattels lands & tenements to be  
levied and to the said Lieutenant Governor by his Surety on his Office for the sum of  
the Commonwealth rendered. Yet upon this condition that if they shall severally make  
their personal appearance before the Judge of the Circuit Superior Court of Law
