

and attorney for this County on the first day of the next Term, and give such evidence as they know in behalf of the Commonwealth against Willis Johnson who stands charged with felony and shall not depart thence without leave of the said Court then this recognizance to be void unless & remain in full force & virtue.

William Pow is appointed sheriff of the said Commonwealth having the sheriff's badge to the Sheriff's Office in the room of Hawkins Pow resigned. And it is ordered that he shall have his work thence.

Ordered that the Sheriff summon all the active Justice of the Peace for the County to the first day of the next Term to recommend fit and proper persons to be used at the Concurrence of the Peace Justice County.

Ordered that the Court be adjourned till the first day of the next Term - *Bony Devany*

At a Court convened by a writ issued and held for the County of Southampton on the 19th day of April 1836 upon the examination of Bryant Edwards of the said County charged with wilfully maliciously and feloniously killing Adam Jones.

In present Benjamin Devany, William S. Everett, Samuel B. Hovey, James Mayot & Nicholas M. Steele Esqts.

The Court being thus constituted the said Bryant Edwards was again set to the bar in custody of the Sheriff of the County. Whereupon for reasons appearing the examination of the said Bryant Edwards is adjourned till the next Court to be held for the County. And on the motion of the said Bryant Edwards he is allowed to give bond himself to be bound in the sum of One hundred dollars and his Sureties in the sum of \$50 each. and thereupon the said Bryant Edwards with Reclam and Edwards Hopkins Brule his attorneys here in Court severally acknowledged themselves to be members & Agent from Robina or Lieutenant Governor of the Commonwealth of Virginia discharging the functions of Governor. that is to say the said Bryant Edwards in the sum of One hundred dollars and his Sureties in the sum of fifty dollars each of their good & chaffable bonds of payment to be paid and to the said Lieutenant Governor and his successor in office for the use of the Commonwealth rendered. Yet upon this condition that the said Bryant Edwards shall make his personal appearance before this Court on the first day of the next Term to stand his trial for the offence of which he stands charged and shall do and perform what by the said Court shall be required and shall not depart without leave of the said Court then this recognizance to be void unless to remain in full force & virtue.
