Ordered that the Sheriff summon all the acting Justices of the Peace for this County to the first day of the next Term to be held at the Court house in the County of South Carolina.

Ordered that the Court be adjourned till the first day of the next Term - *Bony Dwyer*
At a Court continued by agreement and held for the County of South Carolina on the 19 day of April 1856 upon the examination of Bryant Edwards of the said County charged with wilfully maliciously and feloniously stabbing Adam Jones.

The Court being then constituted the said Bryant Edwards was again set to the bar in custody of the jailer of this County. Whereupon for reasons appearing the examination of the said Bryant Edwards is adjourned till the next Court to be held for this County. And on the motion of the said Bryant Edwards he is allowed to give bail himself to be bound in the sum of One hundred dollars and his Sureties in the sum of \$150 each. And thereupon the said Bryant Edwards with Richmond Edwards, Stephen Beale his Sureties here in Court severally acknowledged themselves to be indebted to the Honorable Robinson my Lieutenant Governor of the Commonwealth of Virginia discharging the functions of Governor. That is to say the said Bryant Edwards in the sum of One hundred dollars and his said Sureties in the sum of fifty dollars each of their good & substantial bonds & Rincements to be placed and to the said Lieutenant Governor under his receipt in Office for the use of the Commonwealth rendered. Upon this condition that of the said Bryant Edwards shall make his personal appearance before the said Court on the first day of the next Term to stand his trial for the offence of which he stands charged and shall do and perform what by the said Court shall be ordered and shall not depart without leave of the said Court then this recognizance to be void unless to remain in full force & virtue.
