

Abington Edwards late of the County of Southampton laborer who stands indicted of petit larceny was put to the bar in custody of the Sheriff of this County and thereof answered pleaded not guilty to the Indictment. Afterwards came a jury to wit James Mordaunt, Jonathan W. Scott, Ebenezer Robinson, Benjamin Lamb, Hammy J. Smith, James Bell, Richard Kells, John Larrison, Balwin J. Stephens, John James, Anthony M. Howell & James Bennett who being elected tried and sworn the truth of and when the prisoner spoke and having heard the evidence upon their oath do say that the prisoner is guilty as manner of form as in the Indictment against him is alleged, and at being demanded of the prisoner if any thing for himself he has or knows to say why the Court here should not give judgment against him & (wherein being) offered or alleged in delay of judgment it is considered by the Court that the prisoner be taken into custody in the County Jail of this County for the term of one month from this day wherein he is to be kept on his own & cannot be represented by law and that he receive five lashes on his bare back which the Sheriff is ordered to cause to be inflicted upon him on the 10th of November - In consequence of the fact of this County having been destroyed it is by the Court further ordered that the prisoner be removed by the Sheriff of this County and committed to the Jail of the County of Worcester -

Everett for leave to open a new road the Court of record to whom the said application was referred this day made their report which is ordered to be recorded, and it is further ordered that Edward D. Butler, Amos W. Jr. Rebecca F. Emmett, John A. Paine, Nathan A. Thomas, Mary W. Kells, Thomas W. Vaughan, Hedges, Saml. S. Dingley, Hedges, Rebecca Turner, the heirs of Aaron Wright, the heirs of Nathl. Jones, Bury Waller, Anthony Harris, Amos Harris, Hedges, Jackson & James Jackson the proprietors of the land that which the said road will run be summoned to the next Court to show cause if any they have why the said road should not be opened as proposed.

Ordered that Simon Mearns, Hiram O. Parker & Jordan Edwards & Jesse Parker or any three of them do with the power appointed by the County Court of Worcester, let to the Court and
