Henry Porter who stands charged with breach of the peace upon the complaint of Cordal Brantly, and
this day set to the bar in custody of the Sheriff of this County, and thereupon the said Cordal Brantly &c.
pending other witnesses were sworn & examined and the said Henry Porter fully heard. Whereupon it
is the opinion of the Court & accordingly ordered that the said Henry Porter give security for keeping
the peace for the space of twelve months from this day the said Henry Porter to be bound in the
sum of \$50. and two security in the sum of \$25 each, and that the said Henry Porter do pay the
costs of this prosecution. And thereupon the said Henry Porter together with Darius Battle &
David Reddick - his security have in Court solemnly acknowledged themselves to be indebted to
David Campbell esq. Governor of the Commonwealth of Virginia, that is to say the said Porter in the
sum of \$50. and his said securities in the sum of \$25. each of them respectively, goods & chattels
lands & tenements to be levied and to the said Governor and his Successors in Office for the use of the
Commonwealth rendered. Yet upon this condition that if the said Henry Porter shall keep the
peace and be of good behaviour towards all the citizens of this Commonwealth more especially towards
the said Cordal Brantly for the term of twelve months from this day then they above requiring are to
be void or else to remain in full force.

Ordered that the Sheriff summon all the acting Justices of the Peace for this County to the first
day of August Court next to recommend for proper persons to be added to the Commission of the
Peace for said County.

On motion of Isiah a free negro woman - Ordered that the Sheriff summon all the acting
Justices of the Peace for this County to the first day of October Term next to hear the petition of the
said Isiah for leave to remain in this County according to Law -
Inventory & appraisement of Henry Gaynor at ret. & Records
Ordered that the Court be adjourned till the first day of the next Term.
