Henry Porter who stands charged with breaking of the peace upon the complaint of Gerald Brandy, was
this day set to the bar in custody of the Sheriff of this County, and therefore the said Gerald Brandy &
any other witness were sworn & examined and the said Henry Porter fully heard. Whereupon it
is the opinion of the Court & accordingly ordered that the said Henry Porter give security for keeping
the peace for the space of twelve months from this day the said Henry Porter to be committed to
sum of £50 and two security in the sum of £25 each, and that the said Henry Porter do pay the
costs of this prosecution. And therefore the said Henry Porter together with Brown Battle &

David Godwin - his security here in Court severally acknowledged therewith to be indebted to
David Campbell Esq. Governor of the Commonwealth of Virginia that is to say the said Porter in the
sum of £50, and his said securities in the sum of £25. each of their respective goods & chattels
Lands & tenements to be levied and to the said Governor and his Successors in Office for the use of the
Commonwealth rendered. Yet upon this condition that after the said Henry Porter shall keep the
peace and be of good behaviour towards all the citizens of this Commonwealth more especially towards
the said Gerald Brandy for the term of twelve months from this day thereafter above mentioned to
be void or else to remain in full force.

Ordered that the Sheriff summon all the acting Justices of the Peace for this County to the first
day of August Court next to recommend fit proper persons to be added to the Commission of the
Peace for said County -

On motion of Isabell a free negro woman - Ordered that the Sheriff summon all the acting

said Isabell for leave to remain in this County according to law -
