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Parsons Turner who stands charged with feloniously cutting in the 15th Inst
on Tom Smith of this County with intention to maim & disfigure & do other harm
the said Tom Smith was set to the bar in custody of the Sheriff of this County
(the Court summoned for his examination having failed to meet) and for reasons
appearing to the Court the examination of the said Parsons Turner is adjourned
till the next Court.

The Commencement v George Johnson. Recogn & ret. & continued till the next
Thomas Johnson who stands bound by recognizance for his appearance here to answer
the complaint of Mason Johnson against him for a breach of the peace appeared
in Court in discharge of his recognizance, and for reasons appearing to the Court the
case is continued till the next Court. And thereupon the said Thomas Johnson is
committed to the custody of the Sheriff until he shall enter into a recognizance in
the sum of one hundred dollars with two securities in the sum of fifty dollars each
for his appearance at the next Court to answer the complaint aforesaid.

Commencement v Morris & Recogn & ret. & cont. till next Court.

Henry S. Williams who was summoned to give security for his good
behaviour of James Mellickin appeared in Court whereupon it is by Court ordered
that the said Williams give counter security for his good conduct aforesaid, and his
refusing to give the said security it is ordered that he be displaced from said office
of guardian.

James Mayot a Justice of the Peace for this County this day certified to the Court a
Judgment rendered by him against James Beale for ten dollars for a fine on half
of which accounts the Commencement, and also paid into Court to the Clerk five
dollars one half of said Judgment to be accounted for accordingly to Law.

William Briggs is appointed Committee of Margaret Washington a person of sound
mind & thereupon he gave bond Security according to Law.

Ordered that Martin Compton & John Compton State Heirs Allen Eden and
William R. Edwards Esq. proceed to go on Elias Eden and on & make report.

Ordered that Mr. Sam. Ellis examine State Heirs Allen Eden and on & make report.

Ordered that Nelson Ellis examine State Heirs Allen Eden and on & make report.

Ordered that the Court be adjourned till the morning of 9 October.
