And it appearing to the Court during the investigation of this case that a felony has been committed it is therefore further ordered that the Sheriff take the said James W. Gardner before a Justice of the Peace for this County to be dealt with according to Law.

Ordered that Jacob Warner & John C. Turner do let to the lowest bidder the repair of the bridge across the main run of the Cypress Swamp. as of the road leading to Bridge Keys. receive the same when completed & make report.

Ordered that the Sheriff get off any contingent monies in their hands that otherwise appropriated pay to Richard the sum of \$9 to Thomas Fitzhugh the sum of \$3. to Benjamin Lamb the sum of \$3 the amount of their respective accounts &c.
