

James Turner a mulatto of the County of Southampton labourer who stands charged with feloniously, maliciously, & wilfully and of purpose, stabbing Tom Smith a free negro of the County aforesaid on the 20th of June 1834 at the County of Southampton aforesaid with intent in so doing of maiming, disfiguring, disabling and killing said Smith was this day brought to the bar in custody of the Sheriff of this County. (The Court summoned for his trial having failed to meet) Whereupon for reasons appearing to the Court the Trial of the said James Turner is adjourned till the next Court. and thereupon he is remanded to Jail -

The Court here unanimously in recommending James D. Mafumbung Thomas Peller & William S. Everett Esqrs. to the Governor of this Commonwealth to fit and proper persons to execute the Office of Sheriff of this County for the ensuing year.
