✓ Parsons Turner a mulatto, who is charged with feloniously, maliciously, wilfully & purposefully killing John Smith a free negro of the aforesaid County on the 20th June 1837 at the County of Southampton aforesaid with intention in so doing of permanently disabling & killing said Smith is as again set to the bar in custody of the keeper of Jail of this County and for reasons appearing to the Court the trial of the said Parsons Turner is adjourned till next Court and thereupon he is remanded to Jail -

✓ The Commissioner appointed to view the Leys of bridges & report whether it should be repaired or rebuilt this day made their report. Whereupon the Court doth order that Samuel P. Nicholson, Shadrach Tuttle, Henry Blon & John W.
