Parsons Turner a mulatto of the County of Southampton, subscriber, who stands charged with feloniously, maliciously, willfully and of purpose stabbing Tom Smith a free negro of the aforesaid County on the 23rd June 1807 at the County of Southampton aforesaid with intent to give so doing of maiming, disfiguring, disabling and killing said Smith on the day set to the law in custody of the Sheriff of this County, and being arraigned pleaded guilty. And thereupon divers witnesses were sworn and examined and the prisoner by his Lawyer fully. On consideration whereof it is the unanimous opinion of the Court that the prisoner that he pleased is guilty of unlawful stabbing as against him is alleged. And it being demanded of the prisoner of any thing for himself he hath or can say why the Court should not now proceed to pronounce judgment against him according to law and nothing being offered or alleged in behalf of judgment, it is considered by the Court that the said Parsons Turner be imprisoned in the public jail and Penitentiary house of this Commonwealth for the term of five years, and that he be kept in a solitary cell in the said jail and Penitentiary house on low and coarse diet for the space of one half part of the said term. And it is ordered, that the Sheriff of this County do, so soon as possible after the adjournment of this Court remove and safely convey the said Parsons Turner from the jail of this County to the said public jail & Penitentiary house thereto to be kept, imprisoned and treated in the manner directed by law. And the Court doth recommend to the Governor to shorten the period of confinement in the said Public jail & Penitentiary house to the term of twelve months; and that the said Parsons Turner be remanded to jail.

Brewry Helle of the County of Southampton who stands charged with willfully and feloniously using a knife or some other sharp instrument with which she did inflict a wound on the head & face of Nathaniel Francis, this day appeared in Court whereupon for reasons appearing to the Court she was indicted of the said Helle is adjourned till the next Court.
