Joseph Lewis of the County of Fayette and State of Tennessee who stands
charged with malice, wilfully unlawfully and feloniously stabbing with
a knife, or some such unlawful weapon, Samuel Pond in sundry parts of
this body &c of Samuel MPond of the aforesaid County of Southhampton with
intention to maim disfigure disable or kill the said Samuel MPond as a felon
in the said County of Southhampton called Berlin on the 29th day of June last past
appeared in Court in discharge of his recognizance entered into before Governor
Cold Esq. a Justice of the Peace for this County, and was detained the herein before
of the Sheriff of this County (the Court summoned for his examination having failed
to meet) and his person sundry witnesses were sworn & examined and the facts
by the Court fully heard. On consideration whereof it is the opinion of the
Court from all the circumstances, that the prisoner ought to be tried for the
said Offense at the next Circuit Superior Court of Law & Chancery to be held
for this County. And on the motion of the prisoner he is allowed to give bail
to be bound in a recognizance in the sum of fifteen hundred dollars with two
securities in the sum of seven hundred and fifty dollars each thereupon the
Joseph Lewis together with Jacob Pinos and Joseph S Holland his securities
here in Court severally and jointly pledged themselves to be indebted to David Campbell
Esq. Governor of the Commonwealth of Virginia, that is to say the said Joseph
Lewis in the sum of fifteen hundred dollars and the said Jacob Pinos & Joseph
S Holland in the sum of seven hundred and fifty dollars each to be liable for
respective goods & chattels lands and tenements and to the said Governor and his
executors for the use of the Commonwealth as ordered. Yet upon the condition that
the said Joseph Pinos shall make his personal appearance before the Judge of the
the Circuit Superior Court of Law & Chancery for this County on the first day of the
next term of the said Court by Twelve O'clock in the morning of that day
stand his trial for the felony aforesaid of which he stand charged &c and
the indictment which may be preferred against him and shall not depart
thence without leave of the said Court when the above recognizance be taken
or the term and in full force & return.
