It is ordered that the Sheriff pay the said Murdaugh the sum of five hundred & eighty nine dollars being the amount for which the said bridge was undertaken.

The Register of Nicholas a free agent was examined & certified to be truly made. Ordered that the account of Richard Barrett amounting to \$1.84 be certified to the Auditor of Public accounts for his examination & payment.

Ordered that the Court be adjourned till the morning of 10th October.
