good repair that the old road be discontinued - and the new road be established as a public  
highway.

The Surveyor appointed to view the ground along which Thomas Ridley proposed to alter or  
close this highway made report and upon consideration thereof it is ordered that the said Ridley  
have leave to alter the said road and when the same be opened and put in good repair that  
the old road be discontinued - and the old road be discontinued.

On motion of James D Mapenbury Curator of the Infirmary of Ischæmical Hospital die<sup>d</sup> It  
is ordered that the said Curator be authorized to expend £100. of the principal of his consolidated  
fund each for the two girls <sup>of the principal estate</sup> for their support & education.

Ordered that the hands of Samuel T James be added to work on the road whereof James  
B. Housie is Surveyor.

William W. Cutler is appointed Surveyor of the road in the name of John G Turner deceased  
and it is ordered that the usual hand work theron.

Ordered that the Court be adjourned till the Court is come.
