Sumdry list of indebted County levies amounting to \$288.10 were presented sworn to & allowed

It appears to the Court from satisfactory evidence that Lewis Story was a pensioner of the United States at the rate of eight dollars per month was a resident of said County and died therein on the 26 day of April 1837 and that he left a widow whose name is Melly Story

On motion of Fielding who produces the Sheriff's receipt & License is granted him to keep an Ordinary at Crockettville in this County till May next it appearing that he is a man of good character & not addicted to drunkenness or gaming

It appearing to the Court that a bridge has been established over Shoals Creek which is a navigable stream with which bridge there is connected a draw and for the admission of vessels and other boats in their navigation of the said river and it further appearing that the steam boat Fox daily passes through the said bridge and that John S Middleton the Captain of the said Steam boat is compelled to pay the sum of \$75 dollars to have the said draw each opened and closed and a motion having been made to the said Court by the said John S Middleton to levy upon the people of this County of South Carolina a tax & fee in concurrence with the County of Monmouth its proportion of the said sum of five dollars or of such sum as the Court may think sufficient for the purpose with the view of having the said Steam boat during the ensuing year it is ordered by the said Court that the said application be rejected on the ground that this Court is under no obligation to make

Ordered that McCann Sell as an unsaleable & deliver an act of

Ordered that the account of Harrison P Pope least amounting to \$0.63 etc be certified to the Auditor of Public Accounts for pay
