James Scott having obtained an attachment against the estate of Gray Edwards who hath removed or absconded out of the said County privately for \$188 with interest from the 15th day of February 1836 also the further sum of \$16.60 cents with int from 15th October 1836 due by note and the Sheriff having made return & (here insert return) Whereupon for reasons appearing to the Court the said attachment is continued till next term.

Anthony Vaughn having obtained an attachment against the estate of Gray Edwards who hath privately absconded for \$100 due by note with int from 10th May 1836 also \$40 due by note due the 6th of Oct. 1836 also for \$25 due 11th July 1836 with interest thereon also a note for \$15 with int thereon from 1st Jan'y 1832 also a note for \$16 due 17th July 1835 such int which note is entitled to a credit of \$9.25/100 and the Sheriff having made return (here insert it).
