

John J Drake who stands bound by recognizance for his appearance here to answer the Com-
 plaint of Julia Scarborough against him for a breach of the peace appeared in discharge of
 his recognizance. Whereupon the said Julia Scarborough being sworn & examined under
 said Drake fully heard it is the opinion of the Court & accordingly ordered that the said John
 J Drake give security for keeping the peace for the term of one year from this day himself to
 be bound in the sum of £100 with 2 Sureties in the sum of £50 each; and thereupon the said
 John J Drake with James W Parker & John James his security here in Court severally
 acknowledged themselves indebted unto David Campbell Esq. Governor of the Commonwealth
 of Virginia and his Successors in office that is to say the said John J Drake in the sum of
 £100. and his said Sureties in the sum of £50 each to be levied of their respective goods and
 chattels land & Tenements and to the said Governor & his Successors for the use of the Common-
 wealth as aforesaid. Yet upon this condition that if the said John J Drake shall keep
 the peace & be of good behavior towards the Commonwealth and all its citizens and
 especially towards the said Julia Scarborough for the term of one year from this day that the
 recognizance to be void or else to remain in full force & effect.

In open Court came William Omy who made oath that he was well acquainted with
 Kirby Poythorpe dec. formerly of Southampton County. who died sometime from 25 to 30
 years ago in the said county of Southampton - the deponent further states that the said
 Kirby Poythorpe enlisted in the army of the Revolutionary war, and served in the said
 army about five years; and did not leave the service until the end of the war - the said
 Kirby Poythorpe was at Yorktown in battle at the Siege of Cornwallis - he left the

 to the North - this deponent was never with the said Poythorpe in any engagement
 after that of Yorktown - The deponent further states that the said Poythorpe
 had the following children his eldest was at ^{Yorktown} only, baby, Amy, Sally,
 & Peggy and one son called Benjamin Poythorpe - that the female aforesaid died some
 years ago without issue and the said Benjamin Poythorpe died in October last leaving
 Benjamin, Poythorpe, Patsy or Martha, Poythorpe, and Amy Poythorpe his children
 Martha is the wife Benjamin Andrews Ann is dead without issue and Benjamin
