 a true copy of his register. It appearing to the Court that the former copy has casually lost or destroyed.
 The registers of Miles White, Daniel Whitehead, Helen R. Howard, Dennis Solomon and Peter
 Arto, for negroes or of color to be truly made.

On motion of Black Drury who produced the Sheriff's receipt for the tax of 4 years last twenty

 County till May Court next. It appearing to the Court that the said Mathew & Rice are
 men of good character & not addicted to drunkenness or gaming.
