This day Abby Slag president of Southampton County personally appeared before
the Court and being duly sworn declared that she is the widow of Lewis Slag &^c
she was a Revolutionary pensioner of the United States in the Virginian land, that
she was placed on the Role as appears by the Record on the 21 July 1819, and died
in the Month of April 1839, that she has never married since the decease of her
said husband - she further declares that she was married to the said Lewis Slag some
time in the year 1786. and produced to the Court a register of Testabits of her late
husband in the hand writing of her said husband, in which it appeared that her late
child was born on the 30 December 1787 -

Casper Waller who is charged on oath by Lavinia Simmon a single female person of
this County with being the father of her bastard child this day appeared in Court and
the said Lavinia Simmon & Sunday Utteridge were sworn & examined and the
said Casper Waller by his sound freely heard - The Court upon consideration of all the
circumstances of the case did adjudge the said Casper Waller to be the father of the
said bastard child and that the said child is likely to become chargeable to the County
Therefore it is ordered that that the said Casper Waller be charged with the payment of
£20. annually for the maintenance of said child and that he pay the same to the over
seers of the poor of this County annually until the said child arrives of age of 21
years in case it live so long. and that he pay the costs of this prosecution -

Whereupon the said Casper Waller with Jeptha Drury
his securities here in Court personally acknowledge themselves indebted unto Thomas H
Gaines Esq. Governor of the Commonwealth of Virginia the said Casper Waller
the sum of £120. and the said Jeptha Drury in the like sum of £120 to be divided of
their respective gos: & chattels jointly & severally by the said Governor his executors
