On motion of Nathan B. Boyant heretofore excused for not attending as a grand juror -
 this day Molly Story formerly of Southamster County, personally appeared before
 this Court and being duly sworn declared that she is the Widow of Lewis Story &c.
 who was a Revolutionary pensioner of the United States in the Virginia line, ^{at the rate of \$106 per year.} that
 he was placed on the Roll as approved by the Record on the 21st July 1819, and died
 in the month of April 1839, that she has never married since the death of her
 said husband - she further declares that she was married to the said Lewis Story some-
 time in the year 1786, and produced to this Court a register of the birth of their child -
 now in the hand writing of her said husband, in which it appeared that her eldest
 child was born on the 30th December 1787.

Casper Waller who is charged on oath by Lewisia Simmons a single free woman of
 this County with being the father of her bastard child this day appeared in Court and
 the said Lewisia Simmons & Sandra Alknap were sworn & examined and the
 said Casper Waller by his Counsel fully heard - The Court upon consideration of all the
 circumstances of the case doth adjudge the said Casper Waller to be the father of the
 said bastard child and that the said child is likely to become chargeable to this County.
 Therefore it is ordered that that the said Casper Waller be charged with the payment of
 \$20. annually for the maintenance of said child and that he pay the same to the Treas-
 urer of the poor of this County annually until the said child arrives the age of seven
 years in case it live so long, and that he pay the costs of this proceeding -

Whereupon the said Casper Waller with Jesse Drury
 his friend is here in Court personally acknowledged themselves indebted unto Thomas W.
 Gibson Esq. Governor of the Commonwealth of Virginia the said Casper Waller in
 the sum of \$100. and the said Jesse Drury in the like sum of \$100 to be paid to the
 their respective goods & chattels jointly & severally & the said Governor this day upon
 for the use of the Commonwealth required. It is ordered that if the
