

Ordered that the Sheriff collect from Jacques E. Folks the sum of two dollars due for the bridge near Pelos Mill and account thereof to the County.
 Remitted to Porter. Debt Judgment confessed by the Defendant for the sum of \$53.33 cents and Interest from the 1st day of January 1840. till paid to Cash.
