

Shirreff & anno as aforesaid and thereupon a jury to wit Eljah Nelson and eleven others were sworn to try the issue in this case & return a verdict on these words to wit "We the jury find for the plff the sum of \$20.50 with interest from 12th day of September 1832 till paid." Whereupon on the motion of the Dft and for reasons appearing to the Court it is ordered that the said verdict be set aside and that the Dft pay the costs of this trial and till the next quarterly Term for a new trial to be had thereon upon the Dft paying the costs of this trial.

Ricks v. Booth in Branch - Delt the powers & duties of the Dft North having expired and the said justices awarded to revise the suit to Thomas Prutton Dft of anno De bonis non of the said Sum at Branch being executed it is ordered that the said be revised to the said Thomas Prutton Dft of anno as aforesaid and thereupon came a jury to wit William Miller John Smith and others a verdict in these words "We the jury find for the plff \$29.50 cents with interest thereon from the 12th September 1832 till paid." Whereupon on the motion of the Dft and for reasons appearing to the Court it is ordered that the said verdict be set aside and the cause be continued till the next quarterly Term for a new trial to be had thereon upon the Dft paying the costs of this trial.
