Ordered that the Sheriff of this County out of any contingent money in his hands not otherwise appropriated pay to William G. Stephenson £3 for patrolling.

An account of Robert Cobb's guardianship of a sum of £100 was recd & Cr. to be recorded. On motion of Joseph H. Parker Ordered that Robert R. Edwards who is hereby appointed Sheriff for the purpose deestate settle and adjust the account of Susanna Cobb's account on Robert Goodwyn's estate and make report thereof to Court -

Ordered that Sugars Lane be added to appraise the estate of Military & Brattle dec'd and that any S. of them make report &c.

Ordered that the bonds of John Davis do work on the road of which James Bell is Surveyor - Edwin Blanck having obtained an attachment against the goods of Samuel Polkendine who is removing privately out of this County for £9 due by acct also £1. 17s 6d due 18th Nov. 1838 for £87 9s 6d due 1st Jan'y 1837 subject to a cr. for £4. 677s 6d p^t July 1839 for £15 paid Sept 14th 1837 for £9 17s 6d due 2^d Aug 1839 subject to a cr. of £1. 17s 6d paid 12th 1840 and the constable having made return thereto in the sum of £1. 17s 6d this day came the Sheriff of the County and the debt not appearing to satisfy the attached effects. It is considered by the Court that the Sheriff may satisfy the debt aforesaid due him & directed to be just and the constable and it is ordered that the Sheriff make sale of the attached effects according to Law. Thereupon going directly the payment to the sheriff and the surplus if any return to the effects and what he retains an account of such sale to the Court.

& security according to Law
