Ordered that Mr. Briggs examine the state and settle the account of Charles N. Briggs as guardian of William T. Nicholas and make report thereof &c.

An account Current of John C. Nicholas, Governor of Henry Harts estate was returned & ordered to lie on Term for exceptions.

An account Current of Eldridge E. & Henryson annas on Samuel Harts estate was returned & ordered to lie on Term for exceptions.

An account of Charles N. Briggs' guardianship of William T. Nicholas returned & ordered to lie on Term for exceptions.

Inventory & App^{ts} of Mary & Magdalen returned & Or. to be recorded.

Ordered that the S^{ts} of this County out of any contingent moneys in his hands not otherwise appropriated pay to William & Stephenson £3. for patrolling.

Ordered that Shugart Lane be added to appraisals estate of William & Bostle dec^d and that any 3 of them make report &c.

Ordered that the hands of John Davis do work on the road of which James Bell is Surveyor.

Edwin Hamner having obtained an attachment against the goods of Samuel Polkinton who is removing privately out of this County. for \$9. due by acct. also \$15. 75c due by notes due 1st Nov. 1838. for \$87. 50 due 1st Jan. 1837. Subject to a cr. for \$10. for Oct. 4 177c 6th July 1839

for \$15. paid Sep. 14/1837. for \$9 75c due 2nd Aug. 1839 Subject to a cr. of \$11. 37 1/2 paid July 12/1840. and the constable having since returned (then in debt 11). This day came the S^{ts} by his

att^y and the D^{ft} not appearing to reply the attached effects. It is considered by the Court that the S^{ts} mean by this suit the debt aforesaid and claim ~~to be paid~~ and the costs, and it is ordered

that the S^{ts} make sale of the attached effects according to law. the sum of 100 dollars by the S^{ts} must to the S^{ts} and the surplus if any return to the D^{ft} and that he deliver an account of

such sale to the Court.

Admon. on Samuel Vicks estate granted to John C. Turner who made oath & guardian & Security according to Law.

Booker W. Durham & Mo. on J. E. Bond's Notice proved & Jury must grant the S^{ts} the D^{ft} on said bond according to Law with costs &c.
