It appears to the Court from the evidence of Benjamin Lyfford that Henry Love who was revolutionary pensioner of the United States at the rate of \$31.77 cts per year died Testate in this County on the 27th day of February 1840. Which is ordered to be certified.

It appears to the Court from satisfactory evidence

That day Robert Drury was called by the Court and on his oath examined as to what he knew touching the residence of the absent children of Elias Love - that that his relations had made enquiries for several years past and that one of the relations has lived on the portion of land to which they ^{are} moved.

It appears to the Court from satisfactory evidence that Elias Love who was revolutionary pensioner of the United States died in this County on the 17th day of September 1838 leaving Elizabeth Evans a daughter living in this County - that ^{many years} previous to the death of the said Elias Love, all his other children removed to the West - that now his death, the children who had removed have been written to and their efforts made to ascertain ^{residence} from them but without success and that they have not been heard of within the last twelve months - that the said Elias left no will.

Ordered that the Court be a quorum till the first day of September Term.
