Court it is ordered that the Warrant under which this Court was Summoned be
quashed and that the said prisoners be taken by the Sheriff before some Justice of
the peace for this County to be dealt with according to Law.
Ordered that the Jailer summon a guard consisting of six effective men to guard
the jail of this County during the confinement of prisoners therein charged with Treason
or rebellion or until the further order of this Court.
