

At a Court held for the County of Southampton on the 21st day of September 1840.

The Clerk this day returned a list of the deeds ~~which~~ admitted to record in the Clerk's Office since August Term last including those admitted to record during the said Term, which list being inspected by the Court was ordered to be inserted in the minutes of the proceedings of the day and is as follows -

Deed of bargain and sale from William Brandon and Mary his wife to Thomas Gooch conveying a tract of 120 acres of land was acknowledged in the Clerk's Office on the 16th August 1840 and together with the certificate of the proxy examination and acknowledgment of the wife admitted to Record.

Deed of bargain and sale from John M. Dudley and Lucy his wife to James Henry conveying a tract of 50 acres of land was proved in the Clerk's Office on the 17th August 1840 by one of the witnesses thereto and having been before proved in the office on the 17th May 1840 by two other witnesses was together with the certificate of the proxy examination and acknowledgment of the wife admitted to Record.

Deed of bargain and sale from Jesse Ferguson and Lucy his wife to John C. Brad conveying a tract of 77 acres of land was proved in the Clerk's Office on the 17th August 1840 by one of the witnesses thereto and having been before proved in the office on the 21st March 1836 by two other witnesses was together with the certificate of the proxy examination and acknowledgment of the wife admitted to Record.

Deed of gift from James H. H. Pond to Mrs. Wellens conveying a life right in 50 acres of land was acknowledged in the Clerk's Office on the 17th August 1840 and admitted to Record.

Deed of bargain and sale from Edwin Daugherty and Temperance his wife to Elsie Davidson conveying a tract of 125 acres of land was acknowledged in the Clerk's Office on the 17th August 1840 and together with the certificate of the proxy examination and acknowledgment of the wife admitted to Record.

Deed of bargain and sale from John Lewis and Catherine his wife to William Harris conveying a tract of 6 acres of land was acknowledged in the Clerk's Office on the 17th August 1840 and together with the certificate of the proxy examination and acknowledgment of the wife admitted to Record.

Deed of Trust between Nisbet Branch of the first part, Alfred J. Stephenson of the second part and William J. House corner of Benjⁿ M. Hancock sec^y and in his own right of the third part, conveying a tract of 167 1/2 acres of land, was acknowledged by the parties in the Clerk's Office on the 17th August 1840 and admitted to Record.

Deed of Trust between Richard Harris of the first part, William D. Clarke of the second part and Benⁿ Taylor of the third part, conveying a tract of 300 acres of land, was acknowledged by the parties in the Clerk's Office on the 17th August 1840 and admitted to Record.

Deed of Trust between John A. Turner of the first part, Anthony N. Williams of the second part and John Day and James D. Watrous of the third part, conveying 2 slaves, Philip, Tom Dick, and Phil, was acknowledged by the parties in the Clerk's Office on the 17th August 1840 and admitted to Record.

Deed of Trust between Joseph B. Ferguson of the first part, Joseph Norrell of the second part and John Bennett of the third part, conveying all his interest in the land and slaves belonging to Deem^s Ferguson et al, was acknowledged in the Clerk's Office on the 17th August 1840 and admitted to Record.
