The Clerk this day returned a list of the deeds which were admitted to record in the Clerks Office since August last, including those admitted to record during the said Term, which list being inscribed by the Court was ordered to be entered in the minutes of the proceedings of the day and is as follows-

Deed of bargain and sale from William Board and Lucy his wife to Thomas Cowell conveying a tract of 128 acres of land was acknowledged in the Clerks office on the 14th August 1830 and together with the certificate of the proxy examination and acknowledgement of the wife admitted to Record.

Deed of bargain and sale from John H. Dudley and Lucy his wife to James Clacy conveying a tract of 56 acres of land was proved in the Clerks office on the 17th August 1830 by one of the witnesses thereto and having been before proved in the office on the 17th May 1830 by two other witnesses was together with the certificate of the proxy examination and acknowledgement of the wife admitted to Record.

Deed of bargain and sale from Jno Ferguson and Lucy his wife to John E. Beale conveying a tract of 77 acres of land was proved in the Clerks office on the 17th August 1830 by one of the witnesses thereto and having been before proved in the office on the 21st March 1830 by two other witnesses was together with the certificate of the proxy examination and acknowledgement of the wife admitted to Record.

Deed of gift from James H. Pend to Mr. Wellington conveying a life right in 50 acres of land was acknowledged in the Clerks office on the 17th August 1830 and admitted to Record.

Deed of bargain and sale from Edwin Daughtry and Companion his wife to Elihu Dillard conveying a tract of 125 acres of land was acknowledged in the Clerks office on the 17th August 1830 and together with the certificate of the proxy examination and acknowledgement of the wife admitted to Record.

Deed of bargain and sale from John Lewis and Companion his wife to William Harris conveying a tract of 6 acres of land was acknowledged in the Clerks office on the 17th August 1830 and together with the certificate of the proxy examination and acknowledgement of the wife admitted to Record.

Deed of Trust between Newell Branch of the first part, Alfred J. Stephens of the second part and William D. Howard owner of Bony M. Hancock's land and his undivided right of the third part conveying a tract of 167½ acres of land - was acknowledged by the parties in the Clerks office on the 17th August 1830 and admitted to Record.

Deed of Trust between Richard Harris of the first part, William D. Clark of the second part and Barbara Taylor of the third part - Conveying a tract of 300 acres of land - was acknowledged by the parties in the Clerks office on the 17th August 1830 and admitted to Record.

Deed of Trust between John A. Turner of the first part, Anthony N. Williams of the second part and John Day and Sam'l D. Westbrook of the third part conveying a slaves, Philiz, Tom Dick, and Phil was acknowledged by the parties in the Clerks office on the 17th August 1830 and admitted to Record.

Deed of Trust between Joseph C. Ferguson of the first part, Joseph Morris of the second part and John Barnes of the third part conveying all his interest in the land and slaves belonging to his Burgess estate - was acknowledged in the Clerks office on the 17th August 1830 and admitted to Record.
