Deed of Bargain and sale from Edwin M. Phillips and Matthew A. his wife to Edward Spry con-  
 veying a tract of 150 acres of Land was proved in the Clerks office on the 21<sup>st</sup> September 1840  
 by the witness Thruo and together with the certificate of the proxy examination was acknowl-  
 edgment of the wife admitted to Record.

Deed of bargain and sale from Richard Davison to James E. Crofton conveying a House and  
 lot situate in the Town of Farnham was acknowledged in the Clerks office on the 21<sup>st</sup> Septem-  
 ber 1840 and admitted to Record.

Deed of Trust between James E. Crofton of the first part Littleton R. Edwards of the second  
 part and Richard Davison of the third part conveying a House and lot in the town of  
 Farnham was acknowledged in the Clerks office on the 21<sup>st</sup> September 1840 and admitted to Record.

Deed of Bargain and sale from Edwin Barnard and Elizabeth E. his wife and Edmund Barnard to  
 Arlington Grammar conveying their interest in 75 acres of Land was proved in the Clerks office on  
 the 22<sup>nd</sup> September 1840 by one of the witness Thruo and having been before proved in the office on  
 the 21<sup>st</sup> September 1840 by two other witness Thruo and together with the certificate of the proxy  
 examination and acknowledgement of the wife admitted to Record.

Deed of Bargain and sale from Benjamin Beale and Elizabeth his wife to John Barritt Con-  
 veying a tract of 35 acres of Land was proved in the Clerks office on the 20<sup>th</sup> September 1840  
 by one of the witness Thruo and having been before proved in the office on the 17<sup>th</sup>  
 August 1840 by two other witness Thruo and together with the certificate of the proxy exam-  
 ination and acknowledgement of the wife admitted to Record.

Deed of Bargain and sale from Burton Taylor Esq. James Taylor and Matthew Taylor conveying a  
 tract of 116 1/3 acre of Land was acknowledged in the Clerks office on the 22<sup>nd</sup> September 1840  
 and admitted to Record.

Deed of Trust between Richard Blackheath of the first part Goodman Griffis of the second  
 part and Benjamin Griffis of the third part conveying several tracts of Land was acknowledged  
 in the Clerks office on the 21<sup>st</sup> day of September 1840 by Benjamin Griffis and proved in the  
 office on the same day by the witness Thruo as to the other two parties and admitted to  
 Record.

Deed of Partition between John Boykin of the first part James Turner of the second part  
 and William Young of the third part partition of the land which descended from the late  
 Solomon Turner and was proved in the Clerks office on the 19<sup>th</sup> October 1840 by one of  
 the witness Thruo and having been before proved in the office on the 21<sup>st</sup> Septem-  
 ber 1840 by two other witness Thruo and admitted to Record.
