Deed of bargain and sale from Benjamin Best and Elizabeth his wife to John Barret conveying a tract of 35 acres of Land was proved in the Clarks office on the 28th September 1840 by one of the witnesses thereto and having been before proved in the office on the 17th August 1840 by two other witnesses thereto and together with the certificate of the proxy examination and acknowledgment of the wife admitted to Record—

Deed of bargain and sale from Burton Taylor Esqr to Martha Taylor conveying a tract of 116 1/2 acres of Land was acknowledged in the Clarks office on the 22nd September 1840 and admitted to Record—

Deed of Trust between Richard Blackshire of the first part Goodman C. Griffin of the second part and Benjamin Griffin of the third part conveying seven head of Cattle was acknowledged in the Clarks office on the 21st day of September 1840 by Benjamin Griffin and proved in the office on the same day by the witnesses thereto as to the other two parties was admitted to Record—

Deed of Partition between John Byrnes of the first part James Thomas of the second part and William Jones of the third part partitioning of the land which descended from the heirs of Solomon Thomas and was proved in the Clarks office on the 19th October 1840 by one of the witnesses thereto and having been before proved in the office on the 21st September 1840 by two other witnesses thereto and admitted to Record—
