Deed of bargain and sale from Elizabeth Daugherty to Elizabeth Drake conveying her life right in a tract of 113 acres of land was proved in the Clerk's office on the 21st December 1820 by one of the witnesses thereto and having been before proved in the Clerk's office on the 29th May 1828 by two other witnesses thereto was admitted to Record.

Deed of bargain and sale from James Maylor Esq. John Ellsworth and Jesse Darway to Elizabeth Rochelle conveying a tract of 219 acres of land was acknowledged in the Clerk's office on the 21st December 1820 by James Maylor and having been before acknowledged in the said office on the 16th November 1820 by John Ellsworth and on the 19th May 1828 by Jesse Darway was admitted to Record.

Deed of bargain and sale from John A Hill and Mary A his wife to Amos Dunsen conveying a tract of 264 acres of land was acknowledged in the Clerk's office on the 21st December 1820 by John A Hill and together with the Certificate annexed of the jury examination and acknowledgment of the wife admitted to Record.

Deed of bargain and sale from Benjamin Griffin Commissioner to John P Byrnes conveying a tract of 305 acres of land was acknowledged in the Clerk's office on the 21st day of December 1820 by the said Benjamin Griffin and admitted to Record.

Deed of bargain and sale from Benjamin Griffin Commissioner to Joseph B Council conveying a tract of 644 acres of land was acknowledged in the Clerk's office on the 21st December 1820 by the said Benjamin Griffin and admitted to Record.

Deed of bargain and sale from Benjamin Griffin Trustee &c to James Pratt conveying 155 acres of land was acknowledged in the Clerk's office on the 21st December 1820 by the said Benjamin Griffin and admitted to Record.

Deed of trust between Stephen H Washington of the first part George Laid of the second part and Calvin J Stephenson of the third part conveying a tract of 457 Acres of land and two negroes Ben and Rebecca was proved in the Clerk's office on the 21st December 1820 by the witnesses thereto and admitted to Record.

Deed of trust between Elizabeth Drake of the first part Gilbert Pike of the second part and Jesse Darway of the third part conveying his interest in 113 Acres of land and one horse all his estate heirs wife &c and his crop of cotton and fodder &c was acknowledged in the Clerk's office on the 21st December 1820 and admitted to Record.

Deed of bargain and sale from Simon J Westbrook and Nancy P his wife to Thomas H Westbrook conveying a tract of 160 acres of land was acknowledged in the Clerk's office on the 21st December 1820 by Simon J Westbrook and admitted to Record.

Deed of Release between L R Edwards of the first part Edwards Butler & others of the second part & Thomas H Jones of the third part releasing a certain lot or piece of land situate in and adjacent to the Town of Jerusalem known as the Two Acre lot and the household and kitchen furniture belonging to the same was acknowledged in the Clerk's office on the 22nd December 1820 by L R Edwards the trustee and admitted to Record.
