Deed of bargain and sale from Ebenezer Daughtrey to Ethelared Drake conveying her wife right in a tract of 113 acres of land was proved in the Clerks office on the 21<sup>st</sup> December 1828 by one of the Justices there and having been before proved in the Clerks office on the 24<sup>th</sup> May 1838 by two other witnesses there was admitted to Record.

Deed of bargain and sale from James Augustus Pollock Ellsworth and wife Dorothy to Clemente Rochelle conveying a tract of 219 acres of Land was acknowledged in the Clerks office on the 21<sup>st</sup> December 1828 by James Augustus and having been before acknowledged in the said office on the 10<sup>th</sup> November 1838 by Pollock Ellsworth and on the 19<sup>th</sup> January 1840 by wife Dorothy was admitted to Record.

Deed of bargain and sale from Benjamin Griffin Commissioner to John P Boykin conveying a tract of 305 acres of land was acknowledged in the Clerks office on the 21<sup>st</sup> day of December 1828 by the said Benjamin Griffin and admitted to Record.

Deed of bargain and sale from Benjamin Griffin Commissioner to Joseph S. Council conveying a tract of 546 acres of Land was acknowledged in the Clerks office on the 21<sup>st</sup> December 1828 by the said Benjamin Griffin and admitted to Record.

Deed of bargain and sale from Benjamin Griffin trustee to James Scott conveying 155 acres of Land was acknowledged in the Clerks office on the 21<sup>st</sup> December 1828 by the said Benjamin Griffin and admitted to Record.

Deed of trust between Stephen H. Washington of the first part Thengus Lewis of the second part and Sulien J. Stephenson of the third part conveying a tract of 457 acres of Land and two negroes Ben and Rosey was proved in the Clerks office on the 21<sup>st</sup> December 1828 by the witness above named and admitted to Record.

Deed of trust between Ethelared Drake of the first part Gilbert Nick of the second part and Neck 26th January of the third part conveying his interest in 113 acres of Land and one horse with stock hogs cattle &c and his crop of corn and fodder &c was acknowledged in the Clerks office on the 21<sup>st</sup> December 1828 and admitted to Record.

Deed of bargain and sale from Timon J. Westbrook and Nancy Phis wife to Thomas H. Westbrook conveying a tract of 166 acres of Land was acknowledged in the Clerks office on the 21<sup>st</sup> December 1828 by Timon J. Westbrook and admitted to Record.

Deed of Release between L. R. Edwards of the first part Edwards Bullets & others of the second part Thomas & Jones of the third part releasing a certain lot or piece of land situated in and adjacent to the Town of Jerusalem known as the Tavers Lot and the house and kitchen furniture belonging to the same was acknowledged in the Clerks office on the 25<sup>th</sup> December 1828 by L. R. Edwards the testator and admitted to Record.
