

Deed of bargain and sale from Thomas L Jones and Martha his wife Anthony N Williams and John A Turner conveying a house and lot situate in and adjacent to the Town of Jerusalem and hereon as the Town Lot formerly kept by the said Jones and the household and kitchen furniture belonging to the said was acknowledged in the Clerk's Office on the 22^d December 1840 by the said Thomas L Jones and together with the certificate of the acknowledgement of the wife admitted to Record.

Deed of Release between L R Edwards of the first part William B Smith of the second part and Thomas L Jones of the third part releasing several lots and parcels of land situate in the Town of Jerusalem Viz: parts of Lots No 17, 18, & 19 was acknowledged in the Clerk's Office on the 22^d December 1840 by the parties thereto and admitted to Record.

Deed of Release from James S French in trustee to Samuel Wallace releasing a tract of 105 acres of land was acknowledged in the Clerk's Office on the 23^d December 1840 by the said James S French and admitted to Record.

Deed of Trust between Samuel Wallace of the first part L R Edwards of the second part and James S French of the third part, was acknowledged in the Clerk's Office on the 23^d December 1840 by the parties thereto and admitted to Record.

An agreement between Sigs Cooper and Levi Miller by which the said Miller covenants to support the said Cooper during his lifetime was proved in the Clerk's Office on the 24th December 1840 by two of the witnesses thereto and admitted to Record.

Deed of Trust between Anthony N Williams of the first part Samuel J English of the second part and Samuel A Jones of the third part conveying three negroes Mary Mary and Margaret the property of Anthony N Williams and three Little Lany Martha and Phil the property of John A Turner was acknowledged in the Clerk's Office on the 28th December 1840 by those of the parties thereto and admitted to Record.

Deed of bargain and sale from Thomas L Jones and Martha his wife to James N Stoll conveying a tract of One acre of land was acknowledged in the Clerk's Office on the 31st December 1840 by Thomas L Jones and admitted to Record.

Deed of bargain and sale from Thomas L Jones and Martha his wife to Fortney S. Leckie conveying a certain part of a certain lot in the Town of Jerusalem designated as lot 104. also another lot or piece of land adjoining the same was acknowledged in the Clerk's Office on the 2nd January 1841 by Thomas L Jones and together with the certificate of the giving examination and acknowledgement of the wife admitted to Record.

Deed of Trust between Anthony N Williams and John A Turner of the first part L R Edwards of the second part and Thomas L Jones of the third part conveying a certain lot and piece of land situate in and adjacent to the Town of Jerusalem and hereon as the Town Lot and the balance of the household and kitchen furniture belong to the said lot was acknowledged in the Clerk's Office on the 11th day of January 1841 by the parties thereto and admitted to Record.

Loius Garje. v. c. Appellatus non. Q. ad. Chy. This cause came on again to be heard upon the papers formerly read and the report of the commissioners made at the last term to which no exceptions have been filed and was argued by counsel. On consideration whereof the Court approving & confirming the said report doth adjudge order and decree that the same be held firm and stable forever and that the costs be proportionally borne by the parties.
