Deed of Trust between Thomas Marquay of the first part James Clayton of the second part and James J Clayton of the third part Conveying two horses two brags and furniture one legal Cask and wherry and one Cow and Calf was prove in the Clerks Office on the 18<sup>th</sup> January 1821 by George W Sprig Thomas J Bristol and James Nick the witnesseth thereto and admitted to Records.

Deed of bargain and sale from Francis M Boykin and Hester Ann his wife to Elizabeth E Briggs, conveying a tract of <sup>the interest in</sup> 1 acre of Land was acknowledged in the Clerks office the 18<sup>th</sup> January 1821 by Francis M Boykin and together with the Certificate of the joint examination and acknowledgement of the wife admitted to Records.

Deed of Trust between Benj<sup>t</sup> Branch of the first part Ansdon B Urquhart of the second part and John Urquhart and others of the third part Conveying 65 acres of Land negro man and Peter one horder all my Stock of hogg Cattle &c household and kitchen furniture Crop of Corn founder 25 bushels Utensils and one still Cup and wood was proved in the Clerks Office the 16<sup>th</sup> January 1821 by J L Bailey Robertus Holt and Alfred J Brittle the witnesseth thereto and admitted to Records.

Deed of bargain and sale from Edward M Shields and wife to Polly Brittle conveying a tract of 100 acres of Land was proved in the Clerks Office the 18<sup>th</sup> January 1821 by John Boykin.

Samuel H Holley and Thomas Pinnard the witnesseth thereto and admitted to Records.

Deed of bargain and sale from Patrick B Howell to Thomas Postlethiff conveying a tract of 262 acres of Land was returned to the Clerks office on the 18<sup>th</sup> January 1821 with a certificate unsworn of the acknowledgement therof before the County Court of Gloucester and together with the said Certificate admitted to Records.

Deed of bargain and sale from Richard Duran and Mary his wife to Clemente Rachelle conveying a tract of 75 acres of Land was proved in the Clerks office the 21<sup>st</sup> January 1821 by Richard J Jackson one of the witnesseth thereto and having been before proved in the office on the 16<sup>th</sup> January 1821 by H J Smith and on the 17<sup>th</sup> August 1822 by James Allegot his wife.
